(Tuesday, April 30, 2019) – Late last night, Halifax Water and the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local 227 reached a tentative agreement.

The agreement still needs to be ratified by CUPE Local 227 members and approved by the Halifax Water Board.
