If you have a sister that you believe is a committed union member who is an activist and leader in her union, community or beyond, who is dedicated to equity and labour activism. We encourage affiliated Locals to nominate someone they feel deserving of the CUPE Nova Scotia Betty Jean Sutherland Sister of the Year Award.

This Award will be presented annually at the CUPE Nova Scotia Annual Convention. Completed Nomination Forms MUST be received by April 15th to be considered. No late nominations will be considered.

Nominations must be a member in good standing of a local affiliated to CUPE Nova Scotia.

Nominations must include the completed nomination form and a detailed profile of the nominee, describing her contribution to the labour movement and the advancement of women's rights. A sister who works to raise women's voices within the workplace and community.
